

Final Fundraising Launched with Big Announcement

The River Center at Grant Park Update

Exciting news! At the Anniversary Celebration, the long-awaited announcement was made that the effort to construct a new nature learning and stewardship center in Mission Valley had reached the final stage!

A highlight of the announcement was Assemblymember Chris Ward's inspiring words about the importance of the project. He presented a \$2,500,000 ceremonial State of California check to the River Park Foundation's Board Chair, Mike Schneider, and CEO, Rob Hutsel. The fundraising campaign has now raised more than \$9,000,000!

Our CEO shared that the City of San Diego building permits have been issued so construction could begin as soon as enough funds are raised. What a great day!

It all started more than a decade ago with a conversation between the Grant family and our CEO.

The desire was a simple one, to connect people, especially kids, with nature and the river. The Grant family remembered growing up in San Diego and having opportunities that many kids don't get today – playing outside, getting their hands dirty, and having fun.

Could a former 17-acre sand mining site be part of the solution? The vision of the River Center at Grant Park was born.

The Grant family started this effort and remains its foundation. And now they will match up to \$200,000 in donations to fill the fundraising gap!


Congratulations to our 2023 Awardees!
